



Scholarship Descriptions, Eligibility and Instructions

Titusville High School

Review the descriptions and criteria listed below to determine your eligibility for scholarships managed by the Crawford Heritage Community Foundation.

The *Harry Brown Scholarship*, *Clara H. and Robert M. Davidson Scholarship*, *Elias W. and Mae Hasbrouck Hummer Memorial Scholarship*,* *Friend and Bernice Kerr Scholarship*, *Sharp and Mary Proper Scholarship* and *Melanie Ann Snyder Scholarship* are presented annually to students who have graduated or are about to graduate from Titusville High School, who rank in the top quarter of his or her secondary school graduation class and will be matriculating or enrolling in an accredited two- or four-year college in a program leading to an associate's or bachelor's degree. Award of a scholarship shall consist of one payment for one full academic year.

Approximate award amount: \$1,000

* Preference for the *Elias W. and Mae Hasbrouck Hummer Scholarship* is given to those affiliated with Bethel United Methodist Church, Titusville. Award of this scholarship consists of one payment for one full academic year.

The Associate Charities of Titusville Scholarship Fund

The *Associated Charities of Titusville Scholarship* is presented annually to a graduating senior from Titusville Area High School or Maplewood High School, who plan to enroll in a regionally accredited, nonsectarian, two- or four-year college leading to a degree in Social Work or a related field. Award of a scholarship shall consist of one payment for one full academic year.

Approximate award amount: \$1,000 per year

Ross R. and Shirley A. Casella Scholarship Fund

The *Ross R. and Shirley A. Casella Scholarship(s)* are presented annually to one or more student(s) who have graduated from Titusville Area School District (Titusville, Pennsylvania), Dover (Ohio) High School, New Philadelphia (Ohio) High School or Tuscarawas Central Catholic Elementary School (formerly St. Joseph Catholic Elementary School, Dover, Ohio) and will be matriculating or enrolling in an accredited college, university or technical school. Scholarships are granted with the expectation that they may be renewed each year for a total of four awards.

Approximate award amount: \$20,000 per year

Mark Jeffrey Sampson Memorial Scholarship Fund

The *Mark Jeffrey Sampson Memorial Scholarship* is presented annually to a student who is about to graduate from Titusville High School, who is well-rounded; well-liked; fun-loving; active in sports, student organizations and their community; creative; kind; unbiased in friendship and kindness; and intellectually curious and will be matriculating or enrolling in an accredited two- or four-year college in a program leading to an associate's or bachelor's degree. Award of this scholarship consists of one payment for one full academic year.

Approximate award amount: \$1,000

Hetty Sherwin Scofield Scholarship

The *Hetty Sherwin Scofield Scholarships* are presented annually to select graduating seniors who are residents of Crawford County, Pennsylvania, who plan to enroll in a regionally accredited, nonsectarian, two- or four-year college, and who rank in the top quarter of his or her secondary school graduation class. Award of a scholarship shall consist of one payment for one full academic year. *Approximate award amount: \$250*

APPLICATION

Complete the on-line application form at crawfordheritage.org/titusville-scholarship. Applications will be accepted through 5:00 PM on **April 15**. Supporting documents must be postmarked or delivered to the Crawford Heritage Community Foundation, PO Box 933, Meadville, PA 16335-0933, no later than **April 15**. Incomplete applications will *not* be considered.

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT

The applicant is responsible for having their official secondary school transcript, including courses taken, rank in class and SAT® scores, forwarded to the Foundation by the appropriate school personnel. The transcript should be sent from the school at such time that the mid-senior year grades can be included.

ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Attach a copy of your SAT® score notification from The College Board if your scores are not listed on your secondary school transcript.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

Attach to your application a copy of your Federal Student Aid Report (SAR)*, your most recent IRS Form 1040 and one for **each** parent. If either parent fails to supply an IRS Form 1040 you must include a statement indicating your effort to obtain the form and the contribution toward your education expected from that parent.

Please mark out ALL social security numbers listed on submitted forms to help ensure the security of your and your parents' identities! DO NOT submit attachments to IRS Form 1040—this includes Forms W-2 and 8863 and Schedules A, B, C, D and SE.

NOTIFICATION

Scholarship recipients are notified of their awards in early June. Students not selected to receive scholarships will not be notified due to the volume of applications received. You may visit the Foundation web site at www.crawfordheritage.org to review a complete list of scholarship awards.

* You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form (www.fafsa.ed.gov) to receive your Federal Student Aid Report (SAR). This form can be completed as soon as January 1st of the year you plan to attend college. You can go back to your FAFSA to check status, make corrections to a processed FAFSA and get other information should your circumstances change. Four to six weeks after submitting your FAFSA, you will receive your Student Aid Report (SAR) which summarizes the information you reported. (A sample SAR is available for your reference on our web

site at www.crawfordheritage.org/docs/CompletedSARsample.pdf.) *Applications missing your SAR or other supporting documents will not be considered so please plan ahead!* Contact your guidance counselor for more FAFSA information.
